

2017 Berkeley Artists Guild's (BAG) Annual Members Show

Entry

1. Entries are \$10 per painting or drawing. You may enter two works in each of six categories – (1) oils, (2) watercolor, (3) pastel, (4) mixed media and collage, (5) pencil and graphics and (6) acrylic. Entry fees must be paid at drop off.
2. Drop-Off is Friday, May 5 between 9 a.m. and noon at the Moncks Corner Library, 1003 N. Hwy 52, Moncks Corner, SC 29461, located at the right end of the Berkeley County Offices building.

Reception, Awards and Pick up– Friday, June 2 between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Judge: Celia Wester

Rules for entries:

1. Members must have attained exhibiting status by paying dues in full and attending three (3) meetings in the current year (Oct – May). The BAG's sign-in sheets are used to establish attendance. No exceptions unless a written waiver request due to unusual circumstance is submitted to and approved by the board at least two weeks in advance of the event.
2. Art work must be properly framed, wired and ready to hang. Gallery wrapped canvas will be accepted if the sides are painted. Because of the limited wall space in the venue, the maximum size of the entries may not exceed 22" X 28" including the frame.
3. Works previously submitted to the BAG's annual judged exhibition are not eligible.
4. Art work is to remain on display until the close of the show. Neither the BAG nor the venue are liable for any damage or theft.
5. Only visual fine arts in the form of paintings, drawings and traditional collage are acceptable for BAG exhibitions or shows. Decorative or fabric arts, artisan crafts, photography, computer generated or any other electronically assisted works are not acceptable.
6. There are six categories for entries: 1) watercolors, 2) oils, 3) mixed media and collage, 4) pencil and graphics and 6) acrylics. Cash prizes will be awarded for each category for first, second and third place with a number of honorable mentions available to the judge to be awarded through the whole show. There is a Best of Show and added awards that change from year to year to be announced in meetings or emails. If you have a question about your entry, check with the show chairperson or a BAG board member.
7. Submit only original work completed within the last two (2) years of the show date which has not been done in a workshop, class, or under the supervision of any instructor. Exhibitor must have full copyright and ownership rights to any piece submitted.
8. The Guild show chairperson and committee members present at drop-off will have the right to reject work deemed inappropriate or in violation of any rule.
9. Entries may not be moved after the hanging committee has completed its job.
10. All work must be removed at the closing of the show.
